### EMBED Training Session on blended education at TAMK in Tampere

The "European Maturity Model for Blended Education in Europe" (EMBED) is developed by a consortium of frontrunner universities in blended and online education: KU Leuven, TU-Delft, the

University of Edinburgh, the University of Aarhus, Dublin City University and Tampere University of Applied Sciences. It is coordinated by EADTU and funded by the European Commission.

From September 25–28 a first training session was organised with some 40 representatives of teaching staff, teaching and learning departments, internationalisation departments and university leaders. The objective of the training seminar was

to learn about state of the art of research and innovation in blended and online teaching and learning and to apply new concepts on the current context of their university. ### Prestigious Accreditation for DCU's Online Psychology Degree

### Pepper livens up everyday life in Jyväskylä

One of online distance learning's positive attributes is its flexibility. However, the possibility of engaging in periods of non-enrollment (breaks) usually ends in students dropping out. In this paper, the intention to continue of those students who have not enrolled in the second semester is analyzed, adopting a long-term program perspective. This continuance intention is compared with the subsequent restart (or dropping out) in the third semester. This analysis has confirmed that the models of continuance intention and effective re-enrollment are essentially different. Continuance intention is more rational, even logical, and is mainly based on the level of satisfaction or dissatisfaction with the educational experience (difficulty of the learning materials or perception of the learning system). Effective re-enrollment is more practical or pragmatic, with more importance given to the effects of student dimension variables, for example,

motivations for studying, previous university experience, or environmental variables, such as having a job.

Tampere University of Applied Sciences (TAMK) is coordinating a large Finnish Ministry of Education and Culture funded learning analytics (LA) project. The project has 11 partners. The aim is to advance the versatile use of LA especially in the Universities of Applied Sciences (UAS), the staff competences in LA learning environments and pedagogy, to develop the existing digital learning environments from the perspective of LA, and to create recommendations and policy suggestions for higher education institutions on the effective use of LA.
